Software/Hardware Package

- Field Loader is a software/hardware package that allows third parties to download EFTPOS and custom software direct to Cadmus hardware. Field Loader offers EFTPOS dealers a fast, flexible, cost effective alternative to factory installation of software and applications.
- Administration of software licensing is managed by Cadmus over the Internet. Third parties/dealers can purchase licence credits from Cadmus and these are securely stored by Field Loader. After each successful download credits are deducted from the available balance. Further credits may be purchased from Cadmus and the system is then updated over the Internet.
- New versions of software can be supplied by Cadmus to the third party/dealer via the Internet. Field loader stores these new applications and allows the operator to select which applications will be loaded into the terminal.
- Field loader is supplied with a multi-programming interface, allowing for concurrent loading of up to 16 terminals simultaneously.
- The system is simple to use and is operated via a Windows based GUI interface. All necessary cabling, power supplies, and interface modules are supplied in the kit.
